Dear Sirs,

1. I filed an application to proceed *in forma pauperis* for a small claim case on [REDACTED]. I completed fully the application for a deposal as required by law under oath and I submitted the required proof for food stamps assistance as requested by the staff of the judge even though the only required document is the application i.e. the court forms given under oath and being signed in front of the clerk of the court. However, the Hon. Judge [REDACTED] of the [REDACTED] Justice Court not only refused to follow the law but resorted to harass me by calling a hearing and wasting tax payer's money for a \$31 dollar unpaid deposal and by deliberately delaying my case for 2 weeks just because I am a [REDACTED] and violating my civil and constitutional rights.
2. I heard a rumor that this judge has made that particular justice court a [REDACTED] club where this judge is biased in favor of [REDACTED] against especially against [REDACTED] and has abused the legal process. This judge may be elected by a majority of [REDACTED] community he he can not be allowed to abuse the legal process! Therefore, I request that such abuses of the legal process be thoroughly investigated!
