on [redacted] I appeared in Judge [redacted] courtroom in Superior Court of AZ [redacted] on two class B felony charges with [redacted] Public Defender, as legal representation. I previously defended myself on these charges with a plea of innocent in [redacted] City Court, and I also stated my case in Commissioner [redacted] courtroom on [redacted] I was then appointed Public Defender, [redacted] I had two video conferences with [redacted] from [redacted] Jail in between [redacted] and [redacted]. We discussed the incident I was charged with and it seemed to go well. To my complete surprise when appearing in [redacted] courtroom for the first time, my attorney, the prosecuting attorney and [redacted] himself conferred in a sidebar and [redacted] then said "be ahead and apply for a full rule 11". When I stood and tried to speak out and fire my attorney for unethical practices, I was told to leave the courtroom. Since this incident on [redacted] I filed from [redacted] Jail, a motion to change counsel with [redacted] Judge, and County Attorney [redacted]. On [redacted] The honorable [redacted] acknowledged my motion in proceedings but was not at liberty to rule. As of [redacted] [redacted] is still listed as my counsel.
