it was ordered to inmate and treat my All over
body rash. Neither was done, when my
lawyer brought it back up in court that my
care has gotten worse, the judge ignored it.
My health is getting worse I now have
Asperger's and bronchitis. I was also suppose to
get checked for breast cancer the jail canceled
that appointment. How long is this process
going to be allowed to go before something
is going to be done! my lawyer (

) has argued over 4 or 5 times for
my release, with pretrial, on ROR, secured
bond, signature bond, etc., so that I may
get the health care I need but he refuses
let me. I have been here 16 months while
my health gets worse & worse. Unknowing
of my health's future (because my mother
died of breast cancer) I have yet to be seen
for this but I have symptoms, my husband

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is to be deployed to Afghanistan soon. I have
a 3 year old child which I have not
hugged or touched for over 12 months what
am I to do if my husband is to proudly give
his life for his country, plus I am suffering
from so many health problems. This is my
family, I hope someone is to understand
what my situation is. I am allergic to
everything here in the jail - the medication
the clothing, blankets, sheets, chemicals, soaps,
almost everything. When I do get sick they
have limited means to treat me because they
only have so much so I get worse and the
jail refuses to get me proper treatment which
goes against Judge's orders and then the Judge
lets it go so you see my dilemma it's a
constant revolving door in which I am the
one that suffers, while I wait to die because
it gets pushed onto someone else's hands because
no one wants to take responsibility. Please help
someone crying out for hope. Before I am invisible
intirely.
