At approx 11:50am on 11/11/10, a man and woman entered the leasing of Camelback Cove Apartments located at 4802 N. 10th Street Phoenix, AZ 85014.

The woman approached the desk of Leticia Alvarado Santacruz and introduced herself as "and the man as "her husband, Judge. She told Leticia they wanted to discuss the account balance of her niece who resides in apartment #1030. Leticia explained that discussing accounts with non leaseholders was not allowed and referred them to me, Assistant Manager of Camelback Cove Apartments.

The couple approached my desk and stood in front of me while I remained seated.

I advised both of them that I would need written permission from the resident to release her account info. At this point the woman left and stated "I will get something in writing". The man asked how received two different statements with two different amounts. I replied that I have not spoken to about this, he then asked where the manager was. I said Julianne was here all day yesterday but was at her other

Property today and gave him her contact info. I picked up the phone and called our attorney office, law offices of Scott Clark and asked if the written notice needed to be notarized. They said it did. So when I hung up, I advised him of such then he said menacingly "Do you guys like to play games with people and seems as though you guys like to cause problems". I replied that I was just following company policy and procedure. After explaining the policies to him. His wife came back in and tried to interrupt us. He told her "let me finish with my questions." Then his wife pointed at me and said she had a problem with me. She continued to belittle and call me names such as Snotty, Lazy and rude as she was doing so, he chose to just leave and not say anything. He just sat in his car and waiting for her to continue to abuse me. Her abuse brought me to tears. She finally left then I called my manager and the Phoenix PD and reported the incident. The police advised if they both returned to call PD and they would trespass them. Our attorney advised me to file this.
