ORDER

The complainant alleged that two superior court judges demonstrated bias by ignoring his requests and issuing incorrect rulings. After considering the allegations, listening to seven recorded hearings and reviewing the related minute entries, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct on the part of either judge. The primary issues concern the judges' rulings, which are outside the jurisdiction of the commission. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

I just want to first say that I realize that I am not allowed to put in a complaint because of a judge's decisions, and I'm not. Not really. But his decisions do have an effect on this complaint. How could they not? For instance; I requested for jurisdiction to be proven. It is to my comprehension that I can raise lack of jurisdiction at any time. Per Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure 10.1(b), But Refuses to Require state to prove jurisdiction. Also I have told him how I have not received an arraignment and he ignores this allegation, shouldn't he at least inquire? I tried to explain to him how the Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure are being grossly violated, and he ignores me like he is running around on up. For example, when I told him that I have not been arraigned according to the Rules (14.3) and that instead I had a 12.10 not-guilty hearing, but without authorization from the Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure, he told me that I was wrong and that I had arrangements. WHAT?! That is a flat out lie! When I asked if he knew about the 12.10 not-guilty hearings, he flat out refused to answer. This particular incident happened at the 4-6-11 hearing, at 9:00 AM. If you could see my court dates you would see that he is obviously biased towards me. My first 3 appearances in front of him, he did not even, would not even ask me my name. And I am my own lawyer!! He has denied every motion I have put in, WITHOUT requiring state to respond. It's like he is saying he doesn't need a response from the state because he is going to deny everything. At the last hearing (4-6-11) I even tried to tell him how my trial and speedy trial right was violated because the "last day" was set

over 150 days. 172 days to be exact. He would not hear any of it. At the Hearing on 1-28-11 At 10:00AM I raised the issue of me not having a preliminary Hearing or indictment within the required 10 days of my initial appearance, And He said it was okay because the state filed for an indictment on my 10th day. I told Him that the rules say that they have to have the return of an indictment within the 10 day Rule And He said that's not true. A LIE! Even my advisory counsel said He was wrong. This Judge obviously has never read the Arizona Rules of Judicial conduct. These actions DO NOT support or promote the integrity of the court, And they definitely do not encourage faith in our judicial system. This Judge is beyond "not fair", He does not even allow a fighting chance. He simply ignores the Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure. For these reasons I would ask this Honourable Commission on Judicial Conduct to investigate. If at all possible I request an oral Hearing of some sort. Thank you for your time.
