ORDER

The complainant alleged that a superior court commissioner ignored the law by ordering him to pay spousal maintenance from his disability benefits.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the commissioner engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing all of the information provided by the complainant and the court record, the members of the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the commissioner did not violate the Code in this case. Whether the commissioner acted contrary to the law in awarding disability benefits as spousal maintenance is a legal question outside the jurisdiction of the commission. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

When I first filed my divorce it was because my wife abandon the marriage I never knew where she was I sent investigators to locate to no avail my ex learned in June of 08 (I filed in 07) 4 months after the divorce she filed in court in front of this judge at this point we did a community property hearing the judge gave her half of my disability even tho federal law says you cant I am a 100% percent disabled veteran I cannot work at all it is very well documented and testified to the same my ex testified she was disabled and unable to work even tho she is capable to the judge has never ask for any evidence or proof from my ex but continuously puts the demand on me to provide proof I fall under USC 38 Chapter 11 which also state that my monies shall not be diverted either directly or indirectly this judge has cost me over 20,000.00 in attorney fees and climbing, I even produced a witness who testified to all the money she has scamed from people this judge refuses to follow either state or federal law that she swore

to uphold and follow, my va disability is supposed to not be counted and she is , and she is giving 40% of my social security disability that is directly related to my va disability . And I am only getting 1,200.00 per month which means that my income after giving up part of my monies is 575.00 per month, my charges are as follows: delay or lack of diligence, bias (if you look at the transcript you will see that all rulings are one sided), violating my civil and constitutional rights , this judge never addressed issues of great concern to me, I have had nothing but disregard for me from her since the beginning of the case she has ordered me to split property that I paid for by my own disability months after the divorce but has never ordered the ex to go to work but told me to go to work, I feel that this judge has error in her judgments and order
