ORDER

The complainant alleged a pro tem justice of the peace was rude, biased and prevented her from having a full, fair and impartial hearing.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After review, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Art Hinshaw did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Filing the complaint against I understood that it put me at risk of retaliation and it happened. failure to be impartial makes his action no longer a judicial act but an individual act as the act represents his own prejudices and goals. The Judge acted as a trespasser of the law. I am asking the Commission to investigate actions and take the proper action to restore justice.
