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**ORDER**

August 30, 2024

The Complainants alleged a superior court commissioner did not allow them to be heard in two civil cases, and that the commissioner has exceeded the mandatory retirement age.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. Under Article 6, Section 39 of the Arizona Constitution, there is a mandatory retirement age for judges and justices of a court of record, however, this provision is inapplicable to superior court commissioners which is the position held by the judicial officer in this matter. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Denise K. Aguilar did not participate in the consideration of this matter.
