ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge improperly canceled a protective order.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Roger D. Barton, Louis Frank Dominguez, and Regina L. Nassen did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

The hearing started out okay, but eventually ended up being not about me having an injunction on [] , but on [] irrelevant (A very fake, very fabricated) allegations of me, of things she claims I did, but I never actually did.

It was apparent that the judge believed these allegations to be true, and so therefore believed me to be violent, angry, criminal-minded (which is very far from the truth).

I had absolutely no opportunity to address the new, irrelevant allegations, as I was hung up on when I attempted. I said I did not do anything wrong or illegal. I have never

attacked anyone in my life. I am a huge pacifist. I am vegan, will not drive, believe in AHimsa (Do no harm to any being)

As she decided to void my order, because she saw me as the problem, and not (after believing [] lies), I wanted to

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make it clear that I didn't trust that without the injunction, that ^{she} would cease her threats and attacks on me, and I fear her. I stated a boundary and said that if anyone is violent towards me at any time, that I will call the police. She got very upset, said she is giving permission to harm me, then hung up on me (I was on telephonically).

She also claimed that my incidences of sending 3rd party people to attack me, threaten me, after I had left the state due to her harassment & violent threats, etc. are all non-issues, as she can do that, as long as she herself does not attack me.

So, you can legally hire someone to attack or kill an innocent person ???

I already have a very real fear of this mentally ill woman, hence the reason I felt the need to file the →

injunction on her. After the judge basically gives her permission to be violent towards me and voids my order, I fear her even more. She just got what she wanted - the legal right to be violent towards me.

and meanwhile, I have never done anything to this woman.

Something wrong with this picture?

I have to be in right now,
as I am undergoing treatment,
and this is where my insurance is.

Otherwise, because of my fears of this mentally ill woman, I would not be here. I would like to live in safety of not being attacked by her, or any of her "disciples" while

I am in .. or anywhere, for that matter, as last year, when I was out of state, she found out where I was and sent people to threaten + attack me.

In my opinion, if the judge is going to void my injunction, she could, instead of giving legal permission to attack me, give me some tips on how to stay safe from this violent, narcissistic, delusional woman who has it out for me because of her own insecurities. There is no justice here, from what I can see.
