**ORDER**

October 11, 2024

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge showed bias in her rulings in a criminal case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Denise K. Aguilar and Joseph C. Kreamer did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

This is evident in her consistent refusal to consider any of my six motions, all of which detail instances of police misconduct and issues with my appointed public defender, whom I have been denied the right to dismiss.

Moreover, Judge [redacted] has unjustly removed me from the last two court sessions merely for expressing my concerns regarding her judicial process. The exclusion further underscores her lack of respect for my legal rights and proper court procedure.
