ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge failed to follow current law and was unprofessional while hearing a family court matter.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

**We are Respectfully Requesting the Immediate Removal of
The Honorable Judge
of the County Court, Family Court Division
and Prohibit her from holding a position in Judicial Office again**

Significant allegations of misconduct, poor judgeship, and illegal activity committed by The Honorable Judge (Judge) have mounted with the Arizona Commission on Judicial Conduct (CJC) and in briefs submitted by litigants to Judge and Presiding Judges. There is clear and convincing evidence to support the complaints raised by victims of Judge

The CJC has repeatedly failed to properly investigate complaints alleging violations of the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct committed by Judge

Judge multiple violations of Judicial rules – many of which reflect a flagrant disregard for the law, court rules, and the canons of judicial conduct – as well as extremely concerning patterns of violations and retaliation, make removal from the bench appropriate. Judge retaliating against litigants who file complaints against her rather than changing her behavior is a significant aggravating factor, prompting our urgent request to the Arizona Court.

Judge _____ is knowingly and intentionally placing children and victims of abuse in life threatening danger which makes her immediate removal urgent and of primary importance

Judge _____ should be removed to preserve the integrity of the courts, a censure is not sufficient punishment considering _____ failure to take responsibility, lack of remorse, her failure to change her patterns of behavior after receiving notices of complaints filed against her, and her alleged refusal to participate in investigations against her.

Judge _____ is known for retaliating against litigants who file complaints against her or who file appeals or special actions challenging her rulings.

Judge _____ conduct consistently exceeds the ethical bounds of judicial behavior because the State of Arizona has allowed her to get away with it. Judge

_____ has continued her acts of misconduct since her first day on the bench without any discipline from the CJC, the Family Court Presiding Judge (Judge _____) or the _____ Court Presiding Judge (Judge _____).

Personally, I filed numerous complaints over the last _____ years against Judge _____ due to her acting in an unprofessional manner, issuing rulings inconsistent with Arizona laws, ignoring the Arizona Rules of Family Law Procedures and intentionally violating me and my daughters Federally Protected Constitutional Rights. All those complaints have been ignored by Judge _____, the CJC, Judge

, Judge _____, and former Presiding Judge _____ (Judge _____) for the last _____ years.

When I spoke to the Arizona Governor's office about my concerns regarding the lack of action taken by the CJC, I was told it's because the CJC is understaffed and the Arizona _____ Court is the only agency who has any authority over the CJC. Therefore, I am forwarding my urgent and concerning allegations against Judge _____ to the Arizona _____ Court and all other relevant authorities who may be able to investigate or take action.

I provided Judge _____, the CJC, Judge _____, Judge _____ and Judge _____ with several complaints I filed with the CJC (Complaint 1, Complaint 2, Complaint 3, and other complaints the CJC has not closed yet), a Recall Petition I filed with the _____ County Board of Elections, and a Notice of Claim I filed with the State of Arizona. Judge _____ was made aware of Judge _____ misconduct and failure to follow the law in a Motion for a Change of Judge or Venue filed by my former attorney and many subsequent motions I served her with.

Recently, after a Motion for a Change of Judge was filed with Judge _____, Judge _____ recused herself from a case without any explanation after she already issued several bad rulings in that case. Judge _____ recusal from that case without any explanation on the record infers that the allegations of misconduct set forth against Judge _____ in the Motion for a Change of Judge were accurate.

The willful inaction of the CJC and Supervisory Judges has resulted in irreparable injuries from Judge _____ continued and escalating misconduct. Judge _____ was emboldened by their failure to act and retaliated against litigants including me by issuing additional unlawful and unconstitutional orders harming litigants and innocent children.

Judge _____ has exhibited a pattern of judicial misconduct while in office that cannot reasonably be ignored. All issues stated in this letter have been raised earlier during litigation in numerous cases assigned to Judge _____ including my own. Therefore, **a full and thorough judicial review of Judge _____ cases is appropriate in these circumstances.**

Recently, a _____ petition featuring Judge _____ and hundreds of social media posts have brought victims of Judge _____ together. All of these victims and I knew our rights were violated by Judge _____ and she was breaking the law but we all felt hopeless and believed we were individually targeted by _____ for a myriad of reasons. Many of us were also terrified to come forward, fearing spiteful retaliation from Judge _____ that would ultimately harm our children. Once together, we shared stories of our experiences and collectively performed extensive research on hundreds of Judge _____ cases. Even though all of these victims' cases are remarkably different
