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**ORDER**

May 23, 2025

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge was biased by denying adequate trial time, admission of some exhibits, and ADA accommodations in a family law matter.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

The Complainant also requested to appear before the Commission and present evidence. The Commission found no good cause to support this request, and the request to appear is hereby denied.

Dear Members of the Commission,

I am filing this complaint against Judge \_\_\_\_\_ for her handling of case \_\_\_\_\_, which has been riddled with judicial misconduct:

**Temporary Orders Misconduct:** A previous judge falsely accused me of income misrepresentation without evidence, potentially prejudicing my case.

**Inadequate Trial Time:** My trial was limited to one hour after a year-long wait, with a lengthy ex parte meeting in the back room, excluding me, with \_\_\_\_\_ & the two attorneys, despite my request and offer to pay for more time. ADA Violations: Despite my Complex \_\_\_\_\_, my requests for accommodations were consistently denied, forcing me into harmful court environments.

Forced Sale of Home: Judge \_\_\_\_\_ is mandating the sale of my home, ignoring my evidence of my ex-husband's concealed assets, leading to my son missing school due to our financial strain.

Potential Corruption: Her rulings show clear bias, raising concerns about judicial integrity.

I request:

Recordings and Transcripts: I'm willing to pay for these to review the proceedings.

Investigation: Into Judge \_\_\_\_\_ conduct and the influence of the initial temporary orders. Also, professional advice on potential attorney misconduct claims.

This misconduct has cost me over \_\_\_\_\_, pushing me towards homelessness. I have numerous other examples but am overwhelmed by the bureaucratic process. I seek an opportunity to discuss these issues in person, where I can present my evidence more effectively.

I cannot express how extremely important it is for someone honest with supervisory oversight to meet with me to review this case.

I can easily explain what has happened. On paper, it's more overwhelming at this point than anyone could grasp. I've tried, on paper, in about 1000 formats for 10 years and believe that my own death might be better than having to do that again for a court that throws everything of mine out.

Please allow me to speak with someone. I'll pay for your time. It's our only hope & he's stolen millions of dollars and ruined our lives. We're about to be homeless due to this judge.

My son has suffered more from these orders, that are based on their lies, than you can ever imagine. More than anyone should ever suffer at the hand of a broken judicial system. My child is suffering and this judge wants him evicted from his only home. His father lives with his girlfriend, always has, and has never had room for my son other than with his parents at their house. He abused me for 10 years, cheated on me, lied to me, concealed our assets and accounts, concealed the multimillion dollar company I slaved away to help him build since 2000. He has neglected our son to the point that his life has been (long story but) ruined (I'm always left to clean up the mess), and has done just about every bad thing that I can think of an ex-husband doing but has never seen one bit of consequence from the court.

Do you have any idea how mad I am at God right now for allowing this to happen? I've lost my faith and I'm about to lose my home too.

Please help us.
