The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace is allowing others to use the court's number to become improperly AZ Post certified.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Denise K. Aguilar and Colleen E. Concannon did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

RULE 1.3. Avoiding Abuse of the Prestige of Judicial Office
A judge shall not abuse the prestige of judicial office to advance the personal or economic interests of the judge or others or allow others to do so.
As aforementioned in Rule 1.3.
Attached are records of the ORI number Originating Agency Identifier which is affiliated with AZPOST. The ORI number of _____ court is being used as a "Law Enforcement Agency" for other elected officials to be state certified thru AZPOST in a fraudulent manner.
_____ is as it appears acting as the go to person for _____ who either supervises or has the direct communication with other elected officials to deceive the public, allow the "other" elected officials to become AZPOST certified under a fake name not know to _____ using the ORI number of his elected court.
Continuing, as it appears, _____ has concealed and deceived the public by allowing his elected position and court ORI number to be a tool/scheme for other elected officials to have personal gain in their elected office through AZPOST.
In the record(s) obtained by public records request clearly show that the _____ County Constables are not an agency and do not have an ORI number.
Yet the constables continue to use the ORI number from _____ s justice court flaunting it in public records requests that several elected officials, deputv constables and former certified peace officers now are in fact using the ORI number of _____ s court to be certified under a fake/bogus law enforcement agency.
An ORI (Originating Agency Identifier) number assigned to a justice court cannot be used to identify a law enforcement agency, as ORIs are assigned to criminal justice agencies, not just law enforcement, and the structure of law enforcement ORIs differs from other criminal justice agencies.
The Judge and "others" have deceived AZPOST. Have deceived local Colleges where the other elected officials have used the ORI number of _____ s official court to become AZPOST certified. Deceiving AZPOST for personal gain by the Judge not intervening and stopping such deception and fraudulent schemes.

Rule 2.12. Supervisory Duties
(A) A judge shall require court staff, court officials, and others subject to the judge' s direction and control to act in a manner consistent with the judge' s obligations under this code.
(B) A judge with supervisory authority for the performance of other judges shall take reasonable measures to ensure that those judges properly discharge their judicial responsibilities, including the prompt disposition of matters before them.
(C) A judge shall require staff, court officials, and others subject to the judge' s direction and control to comply with the provisions of the Code of Conduct for Judicial Employees adopted by the supreme court.
A judge is responsible for his or her own conduct and for the conduct of others, such as

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A judge is responsible for his or her own conduct and for the conduct of others, such as staff, when those people are acting at the judge's direction or control.

In appearing before governmental bodies or consulting with government officials, judges must be mindful that they remain subject to other provisions of this code, such as Rule 1.3, prohibiting judges from using the prestige of office to advance their own or others' interests.

Rule 3.4 implicitly acknowledges the value of judges accepting appointments to entities that concern the law, the legal system, or the administration of justice. Even in such instances, however, a judge should assess the appropriateness of accepting an appointment.

Even for law-related organizations, a judge should consider whether the membership and purposes of the organization, or the nature of the judge's participation in or association with the organization, would conflict with the judge's obligation to refrain from activities that reflect adversely upon a judge's independence, integrity, and impartiality.

A judge or a judicial candidate shall not act as a leader in, or hold an office in, an organization such as the Maricopa County Constables.

This is judicial misconduct when a Judge uses their office and ORI number to obtain special treatment for relatives or friends.

This is of paramount concern.
