ORDER

The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace failed to enforce his order of protection.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Michael J. Brown and Colleen E. Concannon did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Failure to enforce the order for protection. ()
 In violated the Order for Protection
 issued against her by coming to my apartment in . A
 neighbor provided a statement as a witness to this violation.
 Despite this, Judge failed to take any action or impose
 consequences for her violation of the order. This failure to enforce
 the court's decision left me vulnerable and ignored the legal protections
 granted by the court.

Failure to enforce Property Retrieval Order. ()
 On I went to retrieve my property from my ranch
 with the assistance of the County Probation Officers
 as my order for protection included a law
 enforcement standby for property retrieval. When I arrived at my property
 was not present, and she refused to cooperate with
 the probation officers when contacted. The officers asked her to provide
 a date to arrange the retrieval of my property, but she hung up on
 them. I informed Judge about this event, but he did
 nothing to enforce the court's order or hold
 accountable for her failure to comply with the order. His inaction
 left me unable to retrieve my belonging and ignored the
 legal directive of the court.

Contradictory Testimony (Animal Abuse Claims)
 During the court proceedings, I was abusive to animals. However, in the body camera footage used as evidence against me, she testified under oath that she contradicted her claim, stating that I would never harm the animals. This contradiction was never addressed by Judge [redacted]. Furthermore, during the hearing, she offered me a quip from my own letter if I agreed to stop posing "herd dogs." If she truly believed I was abusive toward animals, she would not have made such an offer. Judge [redacted] failed to intervene and properly address these contradictions, which damaged the integrity of the court proceedings.

Failure to Address Non-Compliance by
 During the court proceedings, I informed Judge [redacted] that I refused to comply with the court's order to return property. Despite this refusal and her failure to cooperate with the probation officers, Judge [redacted] did not take action to enforce the order or hold her accountable for her refusal. His inaction demonstrates a lack of attention to the non-compliance and my legal right to retrieve my belongings.

I noticed a woman sitting on the ground on the rocks in front of studios and on the ground around at . I texted the new Neighbor in studio to see if he was expecting any company. That a woman maybe in her was sitting in the dark hard to tell the age for sure.

I was taking out my trash and seemed odd having a woman sitting on the ground especially when there was a table with chairs about 3ft away and could have sat in one of the chairs. The woman was facing towards studio and I said hello and she responded in a low voice hello. I proceeded to the trash can at the front of . Upon waking back the woman had left and noticed she was up front now by the main cabin standing in the shadows. I walked towards the area and she turned and walked out of gate and proceeded around the corner headed towards the abandoned gas station to the south of . I walked to the front of the main cabin and she walked down the sidewalk headed south towards the abandoned gas station then out of my sight.

I spoke with to see if he was expecting company and explained what I had seen. He showed me a picture of a woman and asked if it was her. It was too dark to tell for sure. Did look similar to the woman in the picture shown to me. The woman I saw had short brown hair pulled back in a ponytail with bangs, was in good shape with Levi's and a red flannel shirt. She was holding what looked like a styrofoam container like a to go container from a restaurant.
