ORDER

August 13, 2025

The Complainant alleged a superior court commissioner did not acknowledge that DCS violated his rights in a dependency case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Delia R. Neal did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

I have since learned that my original caseworker, [redacted], broke Rule 47.3. According to the [redacted] website this is considered outrageous behavior.

When my results came in, I was exonerated. This was the last charge against me, yet my children were not returned to me.

I made a complaint to the [redacted] + after an investigation my caseworker was replaced. The judge has never acknowledged this.
