**ORDER**

August 15, 2025

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge made improper rulings because the judge is biased in favor of fathers in custody cases.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Regina L. Nassen did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

I explained to the judge that I joined the [redacted] because I wanted to provide a better life for my daughter. My ex-husband and I were living with our parents and even though he didnt agree with my decision I still chose to serve so that way we all could live under one roof again. I initaly filed for seperation then as time went on my ex and I decide divorce would be better. I told him my daughter was with me the entire time up until I left, her dad didnt provide any child support, nor necessities like diapers or clothes. I explained I took her to her medical appointments, I enrolled her into davcare and pay for it myself. I told him that since I joined after bootcamp I gave my ex payments for [redacted] I bought her new clothes, shoes, toys, etc. My family showed me that he purchased a motorbike and when I talked to him I noticed he had a gold chain with a cross on it. Something he didnt have before because I believe he was using the money to buy things for himself and not her, so I stopped paying him. I told the judge I will be working in a tower, so I am not deployable and I will have a home for me and her. My ex and I both wanted full time custody of our daughter.

He gave him full time custody because “ [redacted] ” has family there. My daughter was [redacted] when I sought help through my instructors at my [redacted] acadamy they didn’ t understand how that could happen given my orders.

I have demonstrated that I will do what it takes to provide the life I invisioned for my daughter with or without help. I explained the lack of effort, consideration and irregards her dad showed me about in regards to the care for [redacted]. I explained that he cannot show her how to be a girl and that I can.

In the orders he decided I can have in person parenting time for [redacted] consecutive days in Arizona. I do not get her on [redacted] but he is allowed to have her on [redacted] every year. If I chose to have her visit me in my duty station in [redacted] I had to pay for mv travel and [redacted] I was only able to Facetime her on [redacted] and [redacted] at [redacted] my time. My work shift’ s were every week alternated from [redacted] AND [redacted]

After talking with some lawyers they said that judge is sexist and favors males more. Which is why I am filing a complaint.
