The Complainant alleged a pro tem city court judge improperly denied a protective order.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Michael J. Brown did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Copies of this order were distributed to all appropriate persons on December 16, 2025.

This complaint is submitted by _____ regarding the judicial misconduct of Judge _____ of the _____ City Court. The following outlines a pattern of judicial behavior that constitutes negligence, bias, victim-blaming, and systemic failure to provide protective relief.

1. On _____, I appeared in court requesting protection against attorney _____. Despite presenting evidence of stalking, harassment, and coordinated intimidation with other aggressors, Judge _____ not only denied relief but allowed _____ and his associate to verbally attack me in open court as legal counsel.

2. My witness, _____, was dismissed from the courtroom and later lost his employment as legal consultant, following clear intimidation triggered by _____ and his legal team. The judge refused to hear the full context or consider the chilling effect this has on witness cooperation.

3. Judge _____ publicly challenged my demeanor, facial expressions, and personal credibility without basis, creating a hostile environment. She dismissed documented evidence, including videos, medical letters, and previous orders of protection.

4. The Court's inaction and dismissal of the motion embolden further threats against me and violate victim rights under Arizona law (e.g., A.R.S. § 13-4437 and the Arizona Victims' Bill of Rights).

I respectfully request a full investigation into Judge _____ handling of this matter, her lack of impartiality, her failure to protect a documented victim, and the evident collaboration—through omission or approval—with the abusive tactics employed by opposing counsel.

I am attaching photographic and documentary evidence of these events, including:

- Harassment by _____ in front of the courthouse
- Testimony from _____
- Evidence of professional retaliation against my witness _____
- Screenshots and photos of verbal threats and aggressive presence near my home

This misconduct has deeply impacted my physical and emotional health. The court must be a place of fairness, not intimidation.

I, [REDACTED] hereby declare under penalty of perjury that the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge:

1. My name is [REDACTED] I am over the age of 18 and competent to testify. I have no personal interest in the outcome of this case and make this affidavit voluntarily and truthfully.
2. On [REDACTED] at approximately [REDACTED], I accompanied my friend [REDACTED] as she exited the [REDACTED] Justice Center, located at [REDACTED] Arizona, following a court hearing.
3. Moments after exiting the building, we observed a woman standing near [REDACTED] vehicle, seemingly waiting. The woman then approached a man exiting the building and loudly stated: "[REDACTED]"
4. Immediately afterward, a second woman pulled up in a vehicle to the space directly adjacent to [REDACTED], maintaining prolonged eye contact and making confrontational gestures.
5. Within seconds, a gray [REDACTED] with dark wheels, matching Arizona license plate [REDACTED] pulled into a parking space in front of us. The driver, who we immediately recognized as [REDACTED] attorney for [REDACTED] estranged husband, pointed a cellphone directly at us and began recording [REDACTED] through his windshield.
6. I directly witnessed [REDACTED] sitting in the driver's seat, phone raised in his hand, with a clear line of sight to us. His actions were deliberate, invasive, and clearly intended to intimidate.
7. I understand that Judge [REDACTED] had issued a no-contact order, including indirect and third-party contact, earlier that same day during the criminal hearing. What I witnessed was a violation of the spirit of that order, executed less than an hour after it was issued.
8. Due to work obligations, I am unable to appear in person at the hearing scheduled for [REDACTED] but I am willing to testify under oath if required in any other forum. I submit this affidavit in place of live testimony, affirming its full accuracy.
