**ORDER**

October 3, 2025

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge was biased and made improper rulings in a family law case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Denise K. Aguilar did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

REQUEST DENIED

The Court has received Father's "Request for Statement from Court to Angels Monitoring," requesting authorization to have certain family members attend his supervised parenting time. It doesn't appear that the Order (filed ) specifically authorizes or prohibits others from attending Father's supervised parenting time. Father states that he and Mother agree to the change, but Mother didn't file a timely response and she didn't sign the filing. If the parties reach agreements on changes to the parenting time or decision-making orders, they can submit the proposed changes to the Court for approval under ARFLP 69. Forms and instructions are available at

. If the parties do not agree, either can file a petition to modify that satisfies the requirements of ARFLP 91.3 and A.R.S. § 25-411. But the Court cannot make changes to the parenting time or decision-making provisions absent the parties' agreement and without a hearing. At this time, there are no pending petitions listed on the docket. Accordingly,

**IT IS ORDERED** that Father's "Request for Statement from Court to Angels Monitoring" is DENIED without prejudice.

**THE COURT FINDS** that parenting time that ensures that Father will have substantial, frequent, meaningful and continuing contact with the child would endanger the child's physical, mental, moral or emotional health because Father continues to interrogate the child and engage in other conduct focused on "proving" that Mother is abusive. This has been and likely will be psychologically damaging to the child. The Court, therefore orders the following parenting plan to protect the child's physical, mental, moral, or emotional health. In that regard, the following parenting plan is practical and also maximizes each parent's parenting time to the extent it is in the child's best interests. *See* A.R.S. § 25-403.02.E.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that, effective upon the date this order is entered by the clerk, parenting time shall be exercised as follows:

1. shall remain with Mother as her primary residential parent.
2. All parenting time assigned to Father shall be supervised in accordance with the following terms and conditions:
  - a. Father shall have two supervised visits per week for a period of 2-4 hours. Father's parenting time shall be supervised by a professional agency of Father's choosing and at Father's sole expense. Father shall contact the agency to arrange for supervised parenting time. Mother shall cooperate to schedule Father's parenting time and shall be responsible for transporting the child to and from the agency for parenting time.
  - b. The supervising agency shall be able to observe Father's parenting and shall redirect any problematic behaviors. The supervisor shall provide reports regarding observations of Father's parenting time directly to the court for review.
  - c. Father's supervised parenting time shall occur at one of the following agencies and in Arizona:
