The Complainant alleged a superior court judge did not follow the law.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Colleen E. Concannon, Joseph C. Kreamer, and Regina L. Nassen did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

 a ~~case~~ self-represented litigant. Instead of reviewing the merits of
 my complaint, the judge adopted ~~for~~ the defendant's position
 that my claims were "indecipherable" and dismissed the case
 entirely, depriving me of access to due process and

Statement of Facts and Misconduct

This complaint is brought by the Estate of regarding misconduct committed by Judge in civil proceedings involving a dispute with ().

The judge's conduct includes the following:

1. Refusal to Vacate a Void Judgment

- o A timely and legally sufficient motion under **Rule 60(b)(4)** was filed seeking vacatur of a void judgment due to lack of jurisdiction and other fatal defects.
- o Judge refused to vacate the judgment, despite the fact that under both Arizona and federal law, **a void judgment must be vacated as a matter of law**, not discretion.

2. Denial of Due Process

- o The judge denied a hearing on material issues.
- o Refused to consider sworn, un rebutted affidavits and evidence that challenged subject matter jurisdiction and contractual authority.
- o Failed to provide a meaningful opportunity to be heard, violating procedural due process under the 5th and 14th Amendments.

3. Bias and Abuse of Discretion

- o Displayed clear bias in favor of a corporate creditor despite the absence of a valid contract.
- o Failed to require proof of standing, contract, or authority from .

- Ignored evidence of perfected private administrative process and unrebutted notices establishing legal default.
- 4. **Violation of Judicial Canons**
 - By failing to uphold and apply the law impartially, Judge _____ violated the **Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct**, including:
 - **Rule 1.1** (Compliance with the law)
 - **Rule 2.2** (Impartiality and Fairness)
 - **Rule 2.5(A)** (Competence, Diligence, and Promptness)

Violations Alleged

The conduct of the judge violates the following provisions of the **Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct**:

- **Canon 1:** A judge shall uphold and promote the independence, integrity, and impartiality of the judiciary.
- **Canon 2.2:** A judge shall perform all duties of judicial office fairly and impartially.
- **Canon 2.6(A):** A judge shall accord to every person who has a legal interest in a proceeding the right to be heard.
- **Canon 2.3(B):** A judge shall not permit family, social, political, financial, or other interests or relationships to influence the judge's judicial conduct or judgment.
- **Canon 2.4(B):** A judge shall not permit external pressures or interests to sway decision-making.

Harm to the Complainant

- The Estate of _____ has suffered **significant harm**, including financial loss, reputational damage, and the unlawful enforcement of a void judgment.
- These injuries were directly caused by the judge's refusal to act in accordance with his oath and the law.

Relief Requested

The Estate demands:

- A formal investigation into Judge _____ conduct
- Public disciplinary action, up to and including **removal or suspension**
- Referral to appropriate authorities for bond claim or civil liability, if applicable
