The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace was biased against pro se litigants and did not discipline her staff.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Colleen E. Concannon did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

i had a small claims claim against a former employer for non payment of wages. it had been reported to the Arizona and the had determined that the employer was at fault. the only remaining step was to sue the former employer in small claims court. i was on the final filing stage of the civil suit when i attempted to ask procedural questions regarding filing such as my time frame and what was still required of me for completion. The clerk staff refused all my questions and claimed they did not have to assist me because they where not require to complete forms for citizens. This was a very narcissistic response from staff because i never handed staff any forms or asked them to complete any forms and additionally i believe the staff was obstructing my ability to self serve my legal needs in violation of my 6th amendment to due process under the law. I made every attempt to present this issue to the judge and to my knowledge she never responded or made any disciplinary actions against her clerks. it is written very clearly on the front page of the small claims packet that clerks are required to answer procedural questions and by them refusing and the judge being aware of their conduct with no action the judge is knowingly participating in obstructing my ability to have fair legal rights under the 6th amendment. I am becoming very worried about justice in the state of Arizona lately. i strongly feel i cannot win any legal battles under any venue and any evidence or attempt i make in any circumstance i will receive unfair treatment and bias as this has become completely common practice in my last 3 court venues. my evidence and even actual ability to legally protect myself has been repeated infringed upon.
