ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge made biased rulings in a family law matter.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Colleen E. Concannon, Joseph C. Kreamer, and Regina L. Nassen did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

I believe that Judge was biased on unaccommodating and unreasonable Because he maintained emergency orders From over a year ago That he specifically stated several times during the court hearing that he did not like the hours twice a week arrangements that were at the park and that the father could not adequately bonding time with the child in those conditions.

I requested that the judge grant me a different supervisor Because the current supervisor is the grandmother of my child and I believe she is biased and unreasonable and I also requested that I have a supervisor on my side, and I did state that I would pay for one if I needed to from the state from the state. I also requested specifically as my supervisor And the mother of my daughter refused on the basis that she does not like she made several statements about him during court without evidence to back up her accusations

None of my recommendations were followed and the mother of my daughter made baseless accusations that could not be verified nor were reasonable or fair against my proposed supervisor who has been my friend of years she made allegations against him that amounted to her dislike of him

I understand that in my psychological evaluation it said that at this time my psychological evaluator did not believe that I was fit to have unsupervised visits I understand that but I had made alternative gestures to have more bonding time with my daughter because I am not having my time observed in many scenarios and I had told the judge this and he maintained the status quo in my personal preference was a lazy and unfair assessment

This court case began in and I was up to date on all my child support I make more money now so when they reevaluated my child support I was to pay more and they decided to go from the date in which the initial Emergency orders were put in causing me to have an exorbitant amount of back child support I pay and I don't even get to see my daughter

If there was any justice in the court, they would allow me daytime visit with a supervisor state or of my choice for at least hours In my home I believe that is a safe and a very good Environment for me and my daughter to bond with no interruption from her grandmother

The mother made allegations that my house was not safe for my child without any evidence and without any proof from an inspector to determine if the house is safe or not and I did state in court that I would allow someone other than her or her family to do an inspection in my house to show that it is a safe environment for my daughter.

I believe the final ruling in this case is Unjust bias and completely one sided and it doesn't help that the mother of my daughter works for the courts as a clerk and has on many occasions been difficult uncooperative and unruly and verbally Bullied me and my friend at the court after the final rule under recorded cameras
