ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge improperly held Complainant in jail while waiting for space in a behavioral health facility, to the detriment of Complainant's physical health.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Denise K. Aguilar and Delia R. Neal did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

(3) Not leave the state of Arizona without written permission from the court.

(4) Diligently pursue any appeal if released from custody after judgment and sentence have been imposed.

(5) Maintain contact with your attorney.

(6) Provide a current address and phone number to the Court and to your attorney and immediately notify both of any change.

(7) Do not threaten or invade any type of contact with the alleged victim(s).

(8) Do not drive a motor vehicle without a valid driver's license in your possession.

(9) Do not threaten or invade any type of contact with any person as specified here.

(10) Do not possess firearms weapons of any kind.

(11) Do not consume any alcoholic beverages Do not possess items on any equipment along substance without court permission.

(12) Do not go to scenes of the alleged crime. If checked, you may return one time only with a law enforcement officer.

(13) Do not go to locations as specified here: HOME, WORK OR SCHOOL OF VICTIM

(14) Comply with 3rd party custody release conditions as specified here.

(15) Contact probation or parole office immediately upon release within 72-hours as directed in writing.

(16) Electronic monitoring, if available. (Mandatory if charged with a future offense under Chapters 14 or 35 of Title 33.)

(17) Other: Def shall not be released until bond availability through HOA

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS FOR YOUR PRETRIAL SUPERVISION RELEASE (PSR):

(18) Comply with the assigned pretrial supervision program as specified here: Drug and alcohol monitoring GPS monitoring

(19) Provide a current address and phone number to Pretrial Services immediately and notify of any change.

RELEASING OR ADMITTING TO ANY ARREST, IF YOU ARE NOT A PARTY TO AN APPEARANCE BOND OR A BOND, YOU WILL BE HELD IN CUSTODY UNTIL YOUR NEXT COURT HEARING, UNLESS YOU PROVIDE A \$1000 BOND TO THE COURT. YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO BE PRESENT AT YOUR TRIAL AND AT ALL COURT HEARINGS IN YOUR CASE.
