ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court commissioner improperly denied an order of protection and spoke in a demeaning way.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Denise K. Aguilar and Delia R. Neal did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

To Whom This Concerns,

I submitted another protection order against the defendant, " ". Who is guilty of making multiple false reports against my family and harassment. I made a request for protection for my child with special needs and myself and brought another petition to a different courthouse. This time, I petitioned originally in Municipal, and they stated they do not do telephonic ex parte hearings; therefore, I petitioned with the Courthouse in AZ.

there was a hearing held. A year from the date that all the misconduct occurred to my child and I, the day last year , that this perpetrator made multiple false reports against my family and was excused and allowed, permitted to do so.

Instead of finding support, and acknowledgement of my child and I's sufferings and victimizations, I found myself being spoken to in a demeaning way, interrupted and "overpowered" by a Judge who was more interested in making me seem like I was being dishonest in some manner and making my truth more complicated than it ever needed to be. A Judge who was more interested in being heard, when he is not the victim in this case, and my child with special needs and I are.

Rather than a Judge who was there to listen, support and acknowledge.

I was told that I am a criminal, a "convict", and was being spoken to as if I was nothing but a mere nuisance and a "liar".

I did not appreciate his conduct, nor do I feel it is appropriate. This Judge also, shared a similarity with in terms of "allowing me" to speak. When I am the plaintiff, you are here to listen to me. You are here to consider me. You are here to be receptive and open. Not, to overpower, not to demand the floor because you wear a title and a robe.

I felt very burdened and sad, towards the end of the hearing, I outright told this judge if he is just going to deny the petition to do so I can refile somewhere else.

All this being said, the defendant in this matter, " ", initiated contact with my family evening hours and scared my child with special needs and I to the point we retreated inside our residence and started recording her behavior.

My family has never had the support and acknowledgement let alone consideration that we have needed in our stalking and harassment situation for years because of law enforcement.

We don't have the "option" to call law enforcement in emergency situations and never have. This being said, if I did, our lives would not be the way they are today because of choices, decisions and lack thereof regarding law enforcement. would have never occurred to me and my child with special needs if we were considered by law enforcement to begin with.

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" " hurt my child's ears, and scared the both of us to the point, that we retreated inside our residence, and my child couldn't fall asleep, had to sleep in the room with me, and we both lost sleep and I had nightmares.

The way that I am being looked at and treated by our judicial system is not only hopeless and degrading, it is a reflection of the way that it is broken. None of this would have happened to my family if law enforcement never made the choices, decisions and lack thereof that they did.

I cannot count how many times I have petitioned for protection for my family at this point.

I will not give up for our sake.

I have kept in touch with our landlord and kept an open line of communication with and our landlord concerning our safety concerns.

If all that people have is someone to believe them, and no one chooses to, there is something wrong with the way our Judges, and law enforcement handle crisis and emergencies.

My child and I's innocence in this is proven, and always has been. It has never been acknowledged by anyone, there is a difference.

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
