**ORDER**

January 30, 2026

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge yelled in two separate hearings, prevented Complainant from being heard, prejudged the case in the second hearing, and made multiple errors in the order in a family law case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Judge \_\_\_\_\_ yelled at me for approximately \_\_\_\_\_ minutes during the hearing. She frequently interrupted me after asking questions, preventing me from fully answering. Her manner was combative and argumentative.

This was the most severe incident of yelling. Judge \_\_\_\_\_ again yelled aggressively for roughly \_\_\_\_\_ minutes, interrupting me and displaying hostility throughout the entire trial.

She denied my request to admit evidence regarding the opposing party's abuse of my daughter, without explanation.

She allowed the opposing party's evidence and testimony in full, but then proceeded to confront me about their allegations before I had the opportunity to present my own testimony and evidence.

When she was done yelling, I asked Judge \_\_\_\_\_ if she had already made up her mind about the case. She responded "\_\_\_\_\_". I told her this was deeply concerning because the petitioner had given evidence and testimony however I had not yet given any evidence or testimony. This shows bias and partiality toward the petitioner which is a clear violation of judicial ethics.

Judge \_\_\_\_\_ has displayed consistent bias in favor of the represented opposing party and against me as a self-represented litigant.

She has repeatedly interrupted my testimony while allowing the opposing party uninterrupted time.

Her conduct toward me has been hostile and disrespectful.

The opposing party's lawyer broke a Protection Order for my Medical Information, which barred her from creating electronic copies and sharing it outside of her office. I have evidence of this as she CC'd me on the email.

It should also be noted that much of the biographical information on the docket was entered incorrectly. There are many inconsistencies and false information in the Court Orders and Minute Entries, including:

1. My daughter's birthday is wrong on multiple court orders
2. One court order stated that I was represented by the other party's attorney and that the other party was a self represented litigant, while this has never been true. The other party has had the same lawyer throughout the case and I have been self represented throughout the entire case.
