ORDER

January 6, 2026

The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace accepted faulty paperwork.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Denise K. Aguilar and Colleen E. Concannon did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Copies of this order were distributed to all appropriate persons on January 6, 2026.

"closed," yet Sheriff [redacted] issued a [redacted] press release statewide accusing me of killing [redacted] cows.

In another press release to the media for the actions of [redacted] from [redacted], it was noted: "

I had already been arrested approximately [redacted] minutes before this warrant was executed supposedly based on the findings from the first warrant. [redacted] press release misrepresented the sequence of events by implying that incriminating evidence was discovered in the second warrant and that I was arrested at the time of the search. So again, which is it? Was I arrested under the first search or the second, both of which failed to list me as a suspect? You can't have it both ways, but that seems to be the standard of [redacted], the judges and the prosecution.

These judicial actions—taken together with [redacted] misrepresentations and the County Attorney's reliance on unlawful rulings—demonstrate an egregious breakdown in the rule of law. The continuation of these practices poses a threat not only to my rights but also to public confidence in the [redacted] County justice system.

Grounds for Complaint

- Acceptance of a facially invalid arrest warrant and proceeding as though lawful.
- Proceeding despite absence from official docket in violation of Rule 4.1, Ariz. R. Crim. P.
- Failure to provide written pretrial orders after an explicit ADA accommodation request (28 C.F.R. § 35.160).
- [redacted] minute entry used an [redacted] number as a booking number instead of a valid case number.
- Allowing a bench warrant to issue for non-compliance caused by the court's own omissions.
- Failure to close out the case within the 48 hour period due to lack of filing that was noted when the case was finally closed out 13 days later on [redacted]. It is tragically apparent throughout this case that deadlines do not matter to the courts or the prosecution.
- With the apparent destruction of all the documents contained in [redacted] held in the [redacted] Justice Court, as told to [redacted] on [redacted], it shows the failure of the court to maintain ALL the paperwork of this case

since it is an ongoing investigation, and it raises suspicion that the paperwork destroyed was incriminating to the courts and not me. But now, we will never know and yet the courts have still found a way, illegally, to continue this case against me.

Relief Requested

I request investigation into Judge [redacted] acceptance of defective arrest paperwork, his failure to meet ADA obligations, his role in the issuance of a bench warrant under these conditions, his failure to close out a case in a timely manner, and his failure to maintain the paperwork in an "ongoing investigation."
