**ORDER**

December 23, 2025

The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace failed to follow the law in a civil case and was biased.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

- Dismissal of Valid Evidence: Your ESA documentation from a licensed professional was ignored and treated as invalid.
- Bias or Appearance of Impropriety: The judge appeared to side with the opposing party's unverified claims and mischaracterizations of you as a tenant, despite federal protections and your supporting evidence.
- Resulting Harm: The ruling has caused you homelessness and emotional distress.

Judge ignored a federal statute. Didn't know the law and sided with people that obviously were using lies in court.

Judge failed to acknowledge that I tried to pay rent but was denied because I was being charged illegal pet fees. I said all of this to the judge and the judge ignored all of it. Causing serious harm to me.

Judge failed to acknowledge my disability and my ESA letter. Causing me serious harm and homelessness. Even though my letter is legitimate from a licensed professional. Judge failed to act in good faith. Causing me and my girlfriend to lose all our good rental history and make me her and my dogs homeless. Sided with people lying in court about a window that was never broken to begin with and judge failed to acknowledge the slander.

Judge is very reckless as shown above. Failed to acknowledge my disability numerous of times. Failed to acknowledge a federal statute. Let people lie in her court and failed to acknowledge slander.
