The Complainant alleged a superior court judge had poor demeanor and summarily dismissed her claims in a civil case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Michael J. Brown and Colleen E. Concannon did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

I submit this complaint against Judge _____ of the _____ County _____ Court for judicial misconduct, bias, discrimination, and denial of my ADA rights.

1. Bias and Prejudicial Conduct.

From the outset of my hearing in Case No. _____ on _____ Judge _____ demonstrated bias against me. He repeatedly interrupted my questioning of a witness, shouting “_____” repeatedly in my face as though he were opposing counsel, and refused to allow me to present critical evidence. When I attempted to tell him what the relevance was he interrupted me as if I were wasting his time, would not allow me to speak, and completely disoriented me. I stopped questioning the witness and did not question any others because it was pointless. He was intruding and wouldn't allow relevant questions to be made and he was clearly on the opposing side's team. His behavior destroyed the appearance and reality of judicial neutrality.

2. Dismissal of Motions Without Hearing.

Before the hearing even began, Judge _____ summarily dismissed my motion to dismiss and my counterclaims, refusing to consider my arguments that Plaintiffs' deed was void ab initio and that the court lacked jurisdiction. This was done without discussion, denying me due process. Even at the end of the hearing he did

not tell me what he had determined, he just asked opposing counsel how much his fees were and was laughing with him.

3. Failure to Provide ADA Accommodations.

I suffer from multiple disabling medical conditions, including _____, _____, chronic daily _____, _____, _____, _____, _____ of unknown origin, _____, _____, and _____.

I filed an ADA accommodation request prior to my hearing. Judge _____ ignored my request, failed to engage in the required interactive process, and instead created an environment that exacerbated my disabilities by shouting at me and preventing me from presenting my case. This constitutes unlawful discrimination under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), 42 U.S.C. § 12131 et seq.

4. Denial of Due Process.

By ignoring my jurisdictional arguments, cutting me off during examination, and refusing to provide accommodations, Judge _____ denied me meaningful access to the courts. His actions violated both the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct and my federal constitutional rights.

Relief Requested

I respectfully request that the Commission investigate Judge _____ for misconduct, bias, and ADA violations, and take appropriate disciplinary action to ensure judicial impartiality and compliance with the law.
