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**ORDER**

December 2, 2025

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge failed to follow the law in a criminal case and did not allow him to be heard.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Denise K. Aguilar and Delia R. Neal did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

, during an initial appearance violated my Right to Due Process and to understand the Nature and cause of the accusations against me.

I am detained in [ ] County Jail - I was brought here on a warrant. The day after I was arrested I was brought to video court and presented with a warrant. The warrant does NOT conform to the signature rules of ACTA 1-901. During court Judge read the warrant to me, read the ~~return~~ ~~proof~~ of return of warrant. And then I said "The Judge LIED to me and said he didn't have the warrant in front of him so he could not determine the signature issue. I was like "He denied having the warrant in front of him and as I argued passionately, I was assaulted by "court services officers" and unable to further question the warrant.

After that incident I requested court appointed attorney hoping that the attorney would help with the signature issue. We had a "bail eligibility hearing" recently and, again, I found myself in video court, where I was unable to talk with my attorney. The court session started out with questioning a police officer involved. I had an outburst/objection to the officer's answer - I was unable to talk to my attorney to object on my behalf. After my outburst Judge ordered to have my microphone muted. -- Next page

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Judge            proceeded to go over the unsigned warrant again. My microphone is muted so I cannot object. I am desperately motioning to the unsigned warrant I have in my possession, showing the signature line to the camera. My lawyer is skwirming in his chair and for some reason is not bringing up the signature issue. As I'm desperately motioning to the signature line on the warrant, my attorney says to Judge :

" I thought: "Yes, I want to speak to this signature issue and if my attorney won't do it, I need to represent myself," but I couldn't say anything because my mic was muted. Judge said "            and Judge proceeded over my obvious objections.

I allege Judge            is acting in bad-faith by not allowing me to be heard. I allege Judge            is conspiring with the prosecution and my court appointed attorney to deprive me of multiple liberty rights including my Right to be heard and my right to determine the Nature and cause of the accusation and warrant. ~~My right to determine~~ My right to determine the legitimacy of the warrant. Judge,            is acting shady, straight up lied to my face during initial appearance, obviously does not want to address a defective warrant. It was improper for Judge            to deny me the opportunity to represent myself when my court appointed attorney clearly didn't want to help me and especially after my attorney basically requested to withdraw,            forced him to represent me and did not consult my wishes. As a result I have been injured.
