ORDER

The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace threatened Complainant to not file any more modifications.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Denise K. Aguilar and Cathy Riggs did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Judge [redacted] stole away from me much more than just [redacted] year long order of protection she had issued to my husband against myself. She stole all the memories I should have had with my son, loss of work, loss of ability to work, and loss of everything I had previously known my life to be.

My husband has a history of using the law against his ex-wives and girlfriends. He did this to me. He has called, reporting me to be mentally unstable about five times. Never once with my permission, never once was there a Doctor who could find a single problem with me. [redacted] has tried to have me arrested, calling the police and trying to lie that I hit him when I did not. He got this restraining order under that same spirit.

Simply telling Judge [redacted] that, " [redacted] ' and " [redacted] ' was all that needed to be done to take my son away, my home away, my car away, my ability to care for myself completely was taken from me.

When I contested her decision, a DIFFERENT Judge listened to my case. He ruled unfavorably to me, he seemed very much to me to be unfamiliar with the case, but listened to my husband with more reverence than he did when I spoke. I learned this was illegal what happened. It was supposed to be Judge [redacted] I was to face in court. I again tried to modify the order, because I did not know what to do- not like I could afford a lawyer- and she somehow was able to speak with my Mother and make a minor adjustment to the order. When I requested to see her, Judge [redacted] raised her voice at me (for sending so many requests to be seen), saying, "

Scared, I sort of just took the hit. But I never broke a law. I never once was any type of threat to my husband, much less an "

They breached Due Process by not acquiring any evidence of wrong-doing.

They violated my protected rights from illegal Search and Seizure. They seized my home and car and left it in my husbands possession.

They violated my right as a parent, to be present in the affairs of my child, my ONLY child. [redacted], my husband has [redacted] from [redacted] women. This fact makes me sick- that he is now destroying my life simply because I lost interest in him and only want my son. [redacted] tries to have me arrested repeatedly. And Judge [redacted] aided and abbetted his abuse to me using the legal system.

I do not know what else was violated, but I know I was. Terribly. I need this to be resolved. My son is waiting for me, wondering if his Mommy still loves him or even thinks about him. He's ALL I think about. I am ashamed to be an American.
