**ORDER**

The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace was biased against her in a protective order case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Colleen E. Concannon and Regina L. Nassen did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Filed a protective order on a neighbor year old male from  
two streets over my home out in He hit my lb wire haired (he is my  
service dog for PTSD and severe hearing loss with a ski pole unprovoked. He was walking down my  
street and my dogs were loose with me in my yard while I was watering the lawn in the  
evening almost a year ago to date. My dogs went to greet his dog ( one barks, other quiet, both  
nonaggressive) and his dog came into the yard next to my house about feet off my property and the  
dogs were sniffing each other not fighting, and I hear this Ki yi sound from my wirehaired I  
asked him if he hit my dog and he ignored me and my dog was limping on his right hind. This judge you  
could feel by his verbage he had already taken sides even after my testimony and photos. I tried to  
explain dogs donot know exact boundaries and they did not run out in street. He took the guys side and it  
is a felony to hit or injure a service dog and the iudge made off handed comments like "  
' which was not true. That guy had a lb and mine were both lbs  
soaking wet if that. The guy went on to lie about dates and '  
(which is trespassing) and walking his  
dog now lbs or so off leash (which is also against the law). He also lied how my dog "  
which never happened. The dogs were both near me and my house because I was  
watering. The judge denied the protective order which was somehow changed to a harassment order  
without my knowledge.. I confronted the guy about hitting my dog at a later date which he tried to  
blameshift back on me and said I was harassing him and his wife and I had a weapon. I was carrying in a  
holster a yellow pepper spray gun and I never touched it or threatened him. I was trying to get his  
address to file the order only. I feel I was not heard by this judge, have been an for years and  
recently became disabled and I am years. I do not feel dafe with this guy and I had three incidents.  
I feel he took the guys side because the oppression of women in churches where Judge goes ( I am  
a strong woman), and that he is married to a woman and I had made a comment that  
the guys wife was from and she should go back ( meaning he didnt tell her up front that he hit my  
dog and she was quite suprised about that and I said there's probably more than that that he hasnt told  
you.
