**ORDER**

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge made improper rulings and was biased in a family law matter.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Michael J. Brown and Colleen E. Concannon did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

**Summary of Complaint:**

I am submitting this third complaint to report serious judicial misconduct and procedural violations in my family court case, which has spanned over \_\_\_\_\_ years. The conduct of Judge \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ has undermined my right to due process and obstructed my ability to defend myself.

**Allegations:**

**1. Improper Delegation of Judicial Authority;**

**3. Unlawful Designation as “Vexatious Litigant”;**

Judge \_\_\_\_\_ labeled me a “Vexatious litigant” and barred me from responding further in the case. This designation was imposed without notice, hearing, or findings as required under A.R.S. § 12-3201. It effectively silenced me and denied me access to the court. I have endured \_\_\_\_\_-years of Motions by Petitioner from her two attorneys, month-after-month year-after-year. And all I was doing as a father was fighting for my rights as I am NOT represented by an attorney. I was filing motions to protect those rights. **4. Violation of Due Process and Judicial Ethics:**

These actions violate my constitutional right to be heard, to receive impartial review, and to have my case adjudicated by a lawfully appointed judge. They also violate the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct, including Canons 1, 2, and 3.

**The Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct requires judges to:**

- Uphold and apply the law fairly and impartially;
- Ensure litigants have a meaningful opportunity to be heard;
- Avoid impropriety and the appearance of impropriety;
- Personally discharge their judicial duties unless properly reassigned.

**Relief Requested: I respectfully request that the Commission:**

- Investigate the conduct of Judge \_\_\_\_\_ and Judge \_\_\_\_\_ ;
- Determine whether judicial authority was improperly delegated;
- Review the denial of my right to respond and the disregard of material evidence I supplied in my motions.
- Take appropriate disciplinary or corrective action to restore judicial integrity and protect litigant rights.
