ORDER

The Complainant alleged a municipal court judge failed to follow the law or procedure in his criminal case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

I was supplied a public defender named [Redacted] failed to respond to communications or requests for in person meetings. Any requests on my part for him to obtain evidence was refused. He soon began speaking disrespectfully in our communications so I requested he only communicate with me in writing. He refused to comply then withdrew from my case. I formally requested both new representation

I feel the outcome of my trial has been pre determined.
