ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge incorrectly issued a protective order which later led to a fraudulent adoption.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Roger D. Barton did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. This case is now pending with the Arizona Court(). On
I was advised by of the County Court (whom I
have named in a federal lawsuit with Judge), that the order signed by Senior
Commissioner , who was then a Judge, in reference to order
which was "never officially served."
2. Despite the lack of lawful service, the order was provided to who
unlawfully relied upon the unserved order to initiate the process of selling our child
through a fraudulent adoption scheme.
3. On the invalid order, which states "child in common," the Senior Commissioner actually
documented that he denied my constitutional right to petition, thereby blocking me from
participation in the adoption process and depriving me of notice and opportunity to be
heard regarding my own child.
4. In County, uncontested adoptions where the child is a minor are handled by the
County Attorney's Office, which proceeded without my involvement due to the
unlawful classification of the adoption as "uncontested."
5. In , Prosecutor made false and fraudulent statements
under the penalty of perjury, concerning the same underlying facts involving
and me. Again, these matters are pending before the Arizona Court,

Was used to bring me to court, which violated my constitutional right to fair and due process, and _____ was used as a retaliatory tactic, to deny my constitutional rights under the color of law.

6. The unserved order was further used by _____ Police Officer _____ to arrest me, rendering that arrest unlawful due to reliance on a void or voidable order.
7. As a result of these actions, the Arizona court system denied my constitutional right to petition for approximately _____ years, during which time my son, identified in the order as “child in common,” would now be around _____ years old.
