The Complainant alleged a superior court judge had a conflict of interest and engaged in criminal behavior.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Regina L. Nassen did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

I want to submit a complaint against Judge Judge was caught excepting a bribe from the defendant in my case AG who I have an active compulsory arbitration civil criminal case against. The Bribery deal was to have my civil case transfered to Tax court in order to allow AG /the defendant avoid our mandatory compulsory abitation agreement,civil refund litigation and criminal charges brought against him. Together Judge and defendant AG were caught conspiring against the plaintiff illegally which by law's warrant penalties that include defense lost of judgement. (Under 18 U.S.C. § 201, bribing a public official as defense can lead to the court Order of Forfeiture, and the defense party will lose the ability to contest in court giving judgement to the plaintiff). They were also exposed for knowing each other,working together,being friends outside of court for more than years which is conflict of Interest. AG couldn't deny Bribery charges after getting caught and decided not to fight the case anymore and waived his rights to compulsory Arbitration(I have proof) .My civil case also involves fraud which makes the compulsory arbitration agreement we have in place enforceable Im also paying for arbitration. A fellow colleague of Judge Judge has an assistant by name of " ". has been our pre-trial mediator. agreed that my case should proceed with civil default Judgement after AG / the defendant was caught illegally bribing Judge . Assistant even had asked about the damages I was looking for. My punitive damages are tier 3 for the amount We are agreeing to settle before trial but Judge and AG are trying still trying to cover up a year illegal IRS blacklist ban that involves the defendant/IRS committing fraud acts outside of IRS Business Hours using my name,social and banking information. Assistant is the only court official trying to do the right thing and settle with default judgement. Other than The "Entire" County court officials have joined Judge in conducting fraud activies against me and are trying to cover for AG who has been a friend and colleauge to them all for many years.When I called thier hotline today they were all overly unprofessional,each and every rep primarily due to me exposing AG bribing Judge . Also AG works for the IRS which is conflicting while also being the defendant/lawyer and working for the county court . He is used to winning all of his cases this way and by using federal immunity and conflict of interest with the judges of the court. The Court has now decided to help defendant AG cover up the bribery and continue his decade span of IRS tax fraud schemes against me. Today the entire County Court Officials including Judge have conducted fraud against me by trying to sweep my active mandatory arbitration case under rug, By deleting case from the systems. This illegal behavior was done collectively against me in order to hide the crimes of the defendant AG I need major help or advice in closing out my civil case by default civil Judgement. The entire County staff is supporting AG and Judge with hiding the crimes of stealing my identity,social and tax refunds each year for financial gain outside of IRS Business Hours.
