ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge made improper rulings in a criminal case involving Complainant's daughter.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Denise K. Aguilar, Michael J. Brown, and Regina L. Nassen did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Copies of this order were distributed to all appropriate persons on June 2, 2026.

2. Housing Crisis & Homelessness: Because Judge "let the case sit" without filing the proper Minute Entry, an active warrant remains in the system. This has caused the immediate termination of our Section 8 Housing Voucher. We are facing eviction and homelessness right now because of this judicial inaction.

3. Medical Torture & "Rule 11" Abuse: The Judge is allowing _____ and Probation to use this open case as a "trap" to force monthly injections of _____ and _____. These medications have caused catastrophic physical damage, including a _____-pound weight gain, _____ (_____), and life-threatening choking (_____). The Judge was formally notified of this medical crisis in _____ but has failed to act, leaving my daughter in a "zombie state" while her identity and health are stripped away.

4. Ineffective Counsel & Probation Coercion: My daughter's Public Defender has failed to protect her due process rights, and Probation is using the threat of the "2nd warrant" to reset the clock on her supervision, despite the original warrant being a court error.

I am requesting an immediate investigation into Judge _____ for his failure to perform judicial duties, which is causing irreparable medical harm and the loss of our home.

Dear Medical Director and Clinical Leadership,

I am , mother and guardian of . I am filing this emergency formal grievance regarding severe medical negligence, physical harm, and imminent danger to my daughter's life due to incompetent treatment by , Supervisor , and the clinical team at .

CURRENT CRISIS STATUS:

My daughter is in immediate psychiatric crisis. Since her last forced injection on , has expressed she no longer wants to live and is begging for her suffering to end. She cries out to God asking " ." She is experiencing extreme medication-induced rage, severe physical weakness preventing her from standing, and is at imminent risk of homelessness and further assault.

CRITICAL MEDICAL ISSUES:

1. MEDICAL DISFIGUREMENT & UNDIAGNOSED PCOS

has suffered a -pound weight gain (now lbs), male-pattern baldness, and facial hair growth. While has NEVER been formally diagnosed with , the symptoms are undeniable and severe. had symptoms prior to the injections, but these medications have MAGNIFIED her symptoms to catastrophic levels, causing what can only be described as masculinization of her appearance. Men tell her " ." Children ask her " " The injections have resulted in insulin resistance, likely , and . has admitted these medications " " yet has never monitored levels or addressed the life-threatening endocrine damage. This deadly cocktail is literally transforming my daughter's body. (Photographic evidence attached)

2. PHYSICAL ASSAULT & CONSTANT CHOKING CRISIS

When we lived in _____, _____ was standing at a bus stop wearing a dress when a man approached her, told her "

" and punched her so hard he broke her _____. To this day—YEARS LATER—cannot chew her food correctly or swallow properly. She is ALWAYS, ALWAYS, ALWAYS CHOKING ON HER FOOD. When she chews, you can clearly see how she struggles to eat and swallow. This life-threatening _____ has been completely ignored by your clinic despite multiple reports. She was also assaulted with a bat at a convenience store due to her altered appearance. Your medication-induced disfigurement has made my daughter a target for hate crimes and violence.

3. DESPERATE ATTEMPTS TO PROVE HER GENDER

_____ calls herself " _____ " and identifies as a "girly girl." In her desperation to prove to the world that she is female despite her medication-induced masculine appearance, _____ has walked down the street naked and has flashed people to show them her body. This is not mental illness—this is a young woman whose identity has been stolen by your medications, desperately trying to reclaim it. _____ yearns for a boyfriend, for friends, for hanging out—normal things a young woman her age should experience. She knows nothing about those things because your medications have robbed her of a normal life.

4. MEDICATION-INDUCED RAGE & SUICIDAL CRISIS

Since the forced "porch injection" on _____, _____ is experiencing extreme medication rage. That same evening, while in an agitated state in the kitchen, she was speaking irrationally and I feared for my safety. She is expressing suicidal ideation and asks me " _____ " She is in a state of over-sedation, creating a "zombie" state identical to her roommate _____ who receives similar injections from _____. (Photographic evidence attached)

5. LIFE-THREATENING POST-EATING COLLAPSE

After _____ eats—which she does uncontrollably due to medication-induced hunger—she cannot do anything but lay there in pain. She says "

." She blocks herself from the world and suffers day after day after day. There have been multiple times when I thought my daughter was going to die. The medications cause uncontrollable hunger, leading _____ to consume 100% of family groceries in 1-2 days, followed by hours of vomiting. Paramedics have been called three times, and we have been threatened with arrest. The cycle is: post-injection couch-bound zombie state → extreme binge eating → vomiting and collapse → return to zombie state.

6. COERCED MEDICATION & DEFAMATION

On _____, Supervisor _____ and a nurse came to _____ home and forcibly administered _____ injections on her front porch despite her refusal.

threatened _____ with probation violation and jail time, stating "

." That same night, _____ experienced intense rage and consumed an entire large pizza alone. Additionally, Supervisor _____ has falsely labeled _____ as a "drug addict" to probation officers to cover for the clinic's failures. _____ stimulant use is a desperate attempt to counteract the extreme sedation and "chemical hunger" caused by these injections.

7. INCOMPETENT MISDIAGNOSIS

During this time, _____ failed to maintain her annual housing voucher recertification with _____ Housing Authority, leading to termination of her HUD voucher due to 90+ day absence. _____ now faces eviction (_____ vs _____ rent plus late fees) and imminent homelessness, placing her at extreme risk of further hate crimes and assault on the streets.
